

Coombs Farmers' Institute Scholarship

This scholarship is offered to students who are residents of School District #69 and are proceeding to a post-secondary education institution for agriculture-related studies.

Applicants must show evidence of:

- Citizenship and contribution to school and community affairs (preference will be given to students that have contributed to the agricultural community through 4-H clubs or similar programs).
- Scholastic achievement.

Applications should be in the form of a letter addressed to the Coombs Farmers' Institute detailing the applicant's educational goals and qualifications. Applications must be submitted by May 1, 2007, to the Scholarship Committee of the Coombs Farmers' Institute via Mr. Andrew Brown, Coombs Farmers' Institute, Box 200, Errington, BC V0R 1V0.

Up to two scholarships will be awarded annually. In the event that there are no suitable applicants for the award in any given year, the sponsors of the scholarship may cancel the scholarship for the year under review.

The recipient of the scholarship must advise the sponsors of the scholarship when he/she registers at a post-secondary institution. Arrangements will then be made to have the amount of the scholarship forwarded to the Registrar of the institution.

The student must claim the scholarship within two years of receiving the award.
